The United Nations Global Compact is a strategic policy initiative for businesses that are committed to aligning their operations and strategies with ten universally accepted principles in the areas of human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption.

What is the UNGC Awards?

The Global Compact Korea Network offers the Awards in order to encourage the sustainability management of corporations, public institutions, and non-governmental organizations by strengthening UNGC values and promoting SR activities.

- **UNGC Grand Prize**
The first process is the evaluation* of transparency of CSR reports by assessing sustainability reports published by domestic companies in 2010 and COPs of UNGC participants. The second evaluation process is the comprehensive survey of CSR affiliated stakeholders. The last evaluation process includes the due diligence by the evaluation committee and negative screening.

* Evaluation Criteria: Comprehensive sustainability report evaluation standard developed by integrating major SR indexes such as UNGC, GRI G3 Guideline and ISO 26000 indexes.

• **Best Practice Award**

Selection of outstanding CSR Activity/Project practiced by corporations in the six major areas of human rights, environment, labor, anti-corruption, UN's core agenda of MDGs, and ISO 26000's main clause of community involvement and development.

1. Human Rights Management Award (UNGC principle 1-2)
Best practice in incorporating human rights into business management

2. Respect for Labor Award (UNGC principle 3-6)
Best practice in establishing fair labor management relations and abolishing discrimination in the workplace

3. Eco-Friendly Management Award (UNGC principle 7-9)
Best practice in actively responding to environmental issues and eco-friendly management

4. Transparency and Ethics (UNGC principle 10)
Best practice in efforts to increase transparency and improve corporate governance

5. Community Service Award
Best practice in efforts to promote welfare of domestic communities by providing support and partnership

6. UN MDGs Award
Best practice in achieving the Millennium Development Goals to fight against world poverty through global social contribution

- **Outstanding NGO/Governmental Institution Award**
NGOs with outstanding CSR related performance and distinguished government institutions which promote and support CSR are selected based on internal review by the evaluation committee.

Award Benefits

The UNGC Awards aims to become Korea's most prestigious and authoritative award by selecting outstanding CSR corporations through a rigorous but fair evaluation process.

The Award receiving practices will be published as a Case Study for all the UN Global Compact members and CSR related professionals to share.

The Case Study will be shared among our international networks and distributed at domestic and global conferences.

The Award receiving corporation will be given the opportunity to raise its image, and become the role model for practicing and spreading CSR.

The UNGC Awards will provide a great opportunity to share and promote CSR activities with leading corporations worldwide.
